Thanks to all those who turned in prints and slides for the annual Fort Worth – Dallas contest. As of this writing, we haven't chosen the 15 slides and 15 prints we'll enter in the contest. We're allowed to enter no more than two slides and/or two prints from any one photographer so, on the first round of our selection process we'll select two prints and two slides from each member's submissions then narrow those down to 15 entries for each category. The photographs will be judged at the meeting by a panel of three judges using a score box. We'll attempt to select those entries we believe will do

well in that venue. For instance, high impact images usually score better than fine art photography, as first impressions mean a lot when the judges are only going to see the image for a short time and from some distance.

Many think it's time for our group to purchase a digital projector. The Dallas club is currently using one and has included digitally projected images in their slide classes, judging the two together. Some of their entries in this contest will be digital and they're bringing their digital projector to show them. This will be a good chance to see how projected slides and projected digital images compare.

The contest will be a good opportunity to see another club's work, compare projected digital and slide images and meet some talented photographers from the Dallas club. Hope to see you there.

way to the hill country for a campout.

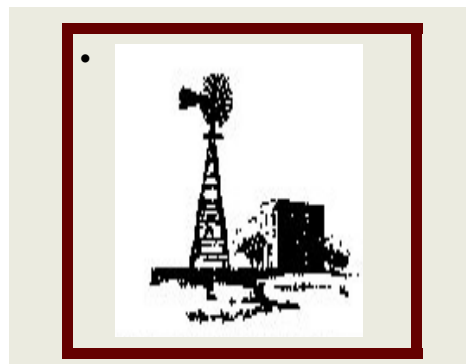
